The mobility began with the kind welcoming of the Cypriot team, who prepared a remarkable musical concert carried out by their students. Students and teachers had then the chance to learn typical dances of all the countries involved, in a sharing activity that allowed the teams to get to know each other better and that at the same time promoted significant cultural exchanges.

The participants visited some of Larnaka's main attractions, such as Saint Lazarus Church and the Castle of Larnaka, learning about the history of the Byzantine Empire and the Romans' influence on the island.

During the visit to the Cyprus Computer History Museum students had the chance to know more about the origins of computer science as well as to learn maths by playing interactive games.

The group also visited Nicosia, the last divided capital in the world, Leftkara, a village known for its silverware and its embroidery, traditions that have been practised since Venetian times and the Salt Lake, where flamingos stop off as part of their migratory route and stay until around March.

During this mobility students and teachers learned how to use social media for a good purpose and had the chance to become more aware of the dangers underlying social media. Finally, students were asked to use an app for creating and sharing videos to produce a document about the cultural exchanges between the several nationalities involved in this project.
